1. Call to Order:

The Chair called the meeting to order at approximately 14:02 Central Time (New Orleans local time) and volunteered to act as secretary. The Chair indicated that all relevant documents are on the TR-8.12 FTP site.

2. Record of Attendance:

Participants were advised to record their attendance with TIA staff and a summary of the attendance is provided later in this report. A quorum was established with 14 of 14 eligible voting organizations present.

3. Review and Approve Agenda:

The Chair noted that the meeting agenda had been distributed prior to the meeting and that it is available as 20-001. The Chair then called the participants' attention to the Participation Notice and Important Notice for Participation (see above) and asked for a motion to accept the February meeting agenda. Dwight Smith moved, and Jerry Drobka seconded, a motion to accept the February meeting agenda as written. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

4. Review and Approve Last Meeting Report:

The Chair noted that the previous meeting report had been distributed by TIA prior to the meeting and that it is available as 19-033. The Chair then asked for a motion to accept the October meeting report. Dwight Smith moved, and John Lambrou seconded, a motion to accept the June meeting report as written. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

5. TIA IPR Policy:

The Chair called the participants' attention to Note 2 on the meeting agenda for information regarding the TIA IPR Policy (see above) that was read to the participants earlier in the day. The Chair asked the question "is there knowledge of patents, the use of which may be essential to any document being considered during this meeting that anyone would like to disclose at this time"? There was no new IPR identified.

6. Old Business:

The Chair called the participants' attention to 20-002 for a summary of the subcommittee activities since the previous meeting. The Chair then called the participants' attention to slide 2, and noted that no conference calls were held since the October meeting.

a. Work Summary:

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 3 for a summary of current and future work items for the subcommittee and provided a brief statement regarding each one.

The Chair provided a brief summary of the following documents that were published in November 2019 with Project 25 on the cover page:

- Two-Slot TDMA MAC Layer Specification 2nd Edition published as TIA-102.BBAC-A
- Two-Slot TDMA MAC Layer Messages 2nd Edition published as TIA-102.BBAD-A
- Two-Slot TDMA MAC Layer Procedures 1st Edition published as TIA-102.BBAE

The Chair indicated that the documents published in November integrate the Control Channel and Voice Channel specifications into a suite of MAC Layer documents and cancel/replace the following documents:

- TIA-102.BBAC Phase 2 Two-Slot TDMA Media Access Control Layer Description (December 2010)
- TIA-102.BBAC-1 Phase 2 Two-Slot TDMA Media Access Control Layer Description Addendum 1 (February 2013)
- TIA-102.BBAD Two-Slot TDMA Control Channel MAC Layer Specification (August 2017)

The Chair then indicated that anticipated future work is to add Link Layer Encryption (LLE) for the Two-Slot TDMA Control Channel and Voice Channel.

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 4 for a summary of the TIA-102 documents published by this subcommittee. The Chair indicated that this content is provided for informational purposes.

7. New Business:

The Chair indicated that there are two items of new business on the agenda.

a. Chair Election:

The Chair indicated that Chair election was announced during the October quorum meeting, and is on the agenda for this meeting. The Chair also indicated that anyone interested in the Chair position was requested to submit statement of qualifications letter and letter of company support per section 6.3 of the TIA Engineering Committee Operating Procedures (ECOP) during the previous meeting. The Chair then indicated that he submitted his nomination documentation to TIA prior to the meeting and that no other nominations were received prior to the meeting. Victoria Mitchell confirmed that TIA did not receive any other nominations.

The Chair then asked if there are any nominations from the floor for Chair. Dwight Smith moved, and Brandon Diemer seconded, a motion to close the nominations for Chair and elect Jim Eastwood as Chair by acclamation since no nominations were received from the floor. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

b. Vice-Chair Election:

The Chair indicated that Vice-Chair election was announced during the October quorum meeting, and is on the agenda for this meeting. The Chair also indicated that the Vice-Chair position is currently vacant and that anyone interested in the Vice-Chair position was requested to submit statement of qualifications letter and letter of company support per section 6.3 of the TIA Engineering Committee Operating Procedures (ECOP) during the previous meeting. The Chair noted that no nominations were received prior to the meeting. Victoria confirmed that TIA did not receive any other nominations.

The Chair then asked if there are any nominations from the floor for Vice-Chair. None were offered, so the Vice-Chair position remains open.

The Chair then asked if there was any other new business to bring before the TR-8.12 subcommittee. None was offered.

8. Review of Current Assignments:

The Chair was to submit a Publication Authorization form to the TIA Standards Department to publish contribution 18-014-R7 as TIA-102.BBAC-A Two-Slot TDMA MAC Layer Specification after allowing time for the Project 25 Steering Committee to determine the disposition of the document. [Complete]

The Chair was to submit a Publication Authorization form to the TIA Standards Department to publish contribution 18-017-R9 as TIA-102.BBAD-A Two-Slot TDMA MAC Layer Messages after allowing time for the Project 25 Steering Committee to determine the disposition of the document. [Complete]

The Chair was to submit a Publication Authorization form to the TIA Standards Department to publish contribution 19-002-R4 as TIA-102.BBAE Two-Slot TDMA MAC Layer Procedures after allowing time for the Project 25 Steering Committee to determine the disposition of the document. [Complete]

9. Schedule Next Meeting:

The Chair indicated there is no need for a meeting in June.

10. Adjournment:

Dwight Smith moved, and John Lambrou seconded, a motion to adjourn the meeting at approximately 14:16 Central Time (New Orleans local time). The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. An attendance roster is on file with the TIA Standards Department.
