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1. Call to Order:

The Chair called the meeting to order at approximately 14:17 Central Time (New Orleans local time) and volunteered to act as secretary. The Chair indicated that all relevant documents are on the TR-8.15 FTP site.

2. Record of Attendance:

Participants were advised to record their attendance with TIA staff and a summary of the attendance is provided later in this report. A quorum was established with 15 of 17 eligible voting organizations present.

3. Review and Approve Agenda:

The Chair noted that the meeting agenda had been distributed prior to the meeting and that it is available as 20-001. The Chair then called the participants' attention to the Participation Notice and Important Notice for Participation (see above) and asked for a motion to accept the February meeting agenda. Dwight Smith moved, and John Lambrou seconded, a motion to accept the February meeting agenda as written. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

4. Review and Approve Last Meeting Report:

The Chair noted that the previous meeting report had been distributed by TIA prior to the meeting and that it is available as 19-009. The Chair then asked for a motion to accept the February 2019 meeting report. Dwight Smith moved, and Jerry Drobka seconded, a motion to accept the February 2019 meeting report as written. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

5. TIA IPR Policy:

The Chair called the participants' attention to Note 2 on the meeting agenda for information regarding the TIA IPR Policy (see above) that was read to the participants earlier in the day. The Chair asked the question "is there knowledge of patents, the use of which may be essential to any document being considered during this meeting that anyone would like to disclose at this time"? There was no new IPR identified.

6. Old Business:

The Chair called the participants' attention to 20-002 for a summary of subcommittee activities since the previous meeting. The Chair then called the participants' attention to slide 2, and noted that no conference calls were held since the February 2019 meeting.

a. Disposition of ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAAD-B Conventional Procedures:

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 3 and indicated that the TIA assigned project number for the 3rd Edition is ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAAD-B and that Motorola Solutions is the document editor. The Chair also indicated that the document was published in August 2015 and that the latest documents are in the "Conventional Procedures" subfolder.

The Chair provided the following summary of the status that was provided during the February 2019 quorum meeting:

- Document is due for ANSI 5-year review in 2020
- Codan Radio and Motorola Solutions provided some editorial comments in comment matrices 19-003 and 19-004 respectively
- Editorial cleanup of Foreword and clauses 1.2 and 6.4.1.4.1
- No substantive changes
- Established comment period closing September 30th using comment template 19-005

The Chair indicated that the comment period was extended to January 31st and that Motorola Solutions provided revised comment matrix 19-004-R1. Comment M03 was modified to utilize the "undated" references method described in the TIA 2019 Style Guide.

The Chair proceeded to slide 4, indicated that none of the comments is substantive, and that the next step is to consider a document action which could be: a) revise, b) reaffirm, c) request an extension, d) demote to TIA only, or e) withdraw. The Chair provided a summary of each of the possible actions and indicated that the Chair recommends the participants consider approving a request for an extension since the comments received thus far are minor editorial in nature and work on Link Layer Encryption is progressing in the Encryption Task Group that may impact this document in the future.

Dwight Smith moved, and Jerry Drobka seconded, a motion to request an extension for ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAAD-B Conventional Procedures. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. The Chair took an assignment to submit an Extension Request form to the TIA standards department.

b. Work Summary:

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 5 for a summary of current and future work items for the subcommittee and provided a brief statement regarding each one.

The Chair indicated that an extension will be requested for the Conventional Procedures 3rd Edition that was published as TIA-102.BAAD-B in August 2015.

The Chair indicated that there is the possibility of revisions to the FDMA Common Air Interface and Conventional Procedures for Link Layer Encryption (LLE) in the future.

The Chair then called the participants' attention to slide 4 for a summary of the TIA-102, EDACS, and TR-8.15 documents currently published by this subcommittee. The Chair indicated that this content is provided for informational purposes.

7. New Business:

The Chair asked if there was any other new business to bring before the TR-8.15 subcommittee. None was offered.

8. Review of Current Assignments:

Participants are to review TIA-102.BAAD-B Conventional Procedures and provide comments using comment template 19-005 by September 30th. [Completed January 31st]

The Chair is to submit the appropriate form to TIA to request an extension for ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAAD-B Conventional Procedures. [New]

9. Schedule Next Meeting:

The Chair indicated there is no need for a meeting in June.

10. Adjournment:

Dwight Smith moved, and Jerry Drobka seconded, a motion to adjourn the meeting at approximately 14:30 Central Time (New Orleans local time). The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. An electronic attendance roster is on file with the TIA Standards Department.
