### 1. Call to Order:

The Chair called the meeting to order at approximately 10:47 Eastern Time (Charlotte local time) and volunteered to act as secretary. The Chair indicated that all relevant documents are on the TR-8.18 FTP site.

### 2. Record of Attendance:

Participants were advised to record their attendance with TIA staff and a summary of the attendance is provided later in this report. A quorum was established with 19 of 21 eligible voting organizations present.

### 3. Review and Approve Agenda:

The Chair noted that the meeting agenda had been distributed by TIA prior to the meeting and that it is available as 19-007. The Chair then called the participants’ attention to the Participation Notice and Important Notice for Participation (see above) and asked for a motion to accept the October meeting agenda. Chris Maiers moved, and Todd Summers seconded, a motion to accept the October meeting agenda as written. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

### 4. Review and Approve Last Meeting Report:

The Chair noted that the previous meeting report had been distributed by TIA prior to the meeting and that it is available as 19-006. The Chair then asked for a motion to accept the February meeting report. Dwight Smith moved, and Chris Maiers seconded, a motion to accept the February meeting report as written. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

### 5. TIA IPR Policy:

The Chair called the participants’ attention to Note 2 on the meeting agenda for information regarding the TIA IPR Policy (see above) that was read to the participants earlier in the day. The Chair asked the question “is there knowledge of patents, the use of which may be essential to any document being considered during this meeting that anyone would like to disclose at this time”? There was no new IPR identified.

## 6. Old Business:

The Chair called the participants' attention to 19-011-R1 for a summary of subcommittee activities since the previous meeting. The Chair then called the participants' attention to slide 2, and noted that no conference calls were held since the February meeting.

### a. Disposition of TIA-PN-88.2-E Wireless Communications Systems Performance in Noise and Interference-Limited Situations Part 2: Propagation and Noise:

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 3 and indicated that the TIA assigned project number for the 6<sup>th</sup> Edition is TIA-PN-88.2-E. The Chair also indicated that the document was published in January 2016, ACD Telecom was the document editor, and that it is a Working Group 2 document. The Chair then indicated that the latest documents are in the "TSB-88.2" subfolder.

The Chair reminded the participants' that Motorola Solutions identified an issue during the June TR-8 meeting regarding the Local Clutter Attenuation values being required by consultants in cases where they do not necessarily apply. The Chair indicated that Working Group 2 held six conference calls to discuss the issue and draft revisions for consideration. The Chair also indicated that during those conference calls, Softwright noted that the reference to NLCD 2011 should be updated to recently released NLCD 2016 (National Land Cover Database), ACD Telecom proposed a new subclause for "Seasonal Variation", and various organizations proposed combining Tables 2 – 5 as a result of the proposed revisions. The Chair then indicated that the latest draft content is available in contributions 19-009 and 19-010.

The Chair indicated that the Working Group 2 consensus is to incorporate these proposed revisions in Revision F once drafting is complete. The Chair then asked if there was a motion from the floor to open a project for Revision F of TSB-88.2.

Tom Rubinstein moved, and Bernie Olson seconded, a motion to open a project for Revision of TIA-PN-88.2-E Wireless Communications Systems Performance in Noise and Interference-Limited Situations Part 2: Propagation and Noise with scope of addressing the content proposed by Working Group 2. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. The Chair took an assignment to submit the appropriate form to the TIA Standards Department to open a project for TIA-PN-88.2-F which would ultimately be published as TSB-88.2-F.

The Chair indicated that the Working Group 2 goal is to complete work on the Revision F draft proposal well in advance of the February meetings and noted that it is difficult to find a time when the subcommittee can establish a quorum for a vote to approve for ballot. The Chair then indicated that TIA allows subcommittees to hold a quorum vote via email, so the plan is to hold a 15-day email quorum vote to approve the Revision F draft proposal for ballot once drafting in Working Group 2 is complete.

The Chair indicated that Motorola Solutions has volunteered to be editor for Revision F and that the next Working Group 2 conference call is scheduled for October 22<sup>nd</sup> at 4pm eastern time, 1pm pacific time.

### b. Disposition of TIA-PN-88.3-E Wireless Communications Systems Performance in Noise and Interference-Limited Situations Part 3: Recommended Methods for Technology-Independent Narrowband Performance Verification:

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 4 and indicated that the TIA assigned project number for the 6<sup>th</sup> Edition is TIA-PN-88.3-E. The Chair also indicated that the document was published in November 2018, Softwright was the document editor, and that it is a Working Group 1 document. The Chair then indicated that the latest documents are in the "TSB-88.3" subfolder.

The Chair indicated that L3Harris identified an issue regarding the use of attenuators during coverage verification testing and provided draft text to address the issue in contribution 19-008. The Chair also indicated that Working Group 2 has noted that there may be possible near-far interference issues for radios with wide pre-selectors in proximity of short-tower cellular systems at 700 and 800 MHz that may impact TSB-88.1-E and/or TSB-88.3-E which are both Working Group 1 documents.

The Chair requested that Working Group 1 review the L3Harris proposal and determine appropriate actions. The Chair also requested Working Group 1 to take up discussion of the near-far interference issue and determine appropriate document actions. The Chair then indicated that the next Working Group 1 conference call will be announced shortly and will like occur during the week of October 21<sup>st</sup>.

Chris Maiers noted that in-building boosters and in-building cellular are becoming frequent issues and asked if the L3Harris proposal would verify coverage for these situations. The Chair indicated that these documents are not requirements documents and do not provide assurance of predicted coverage as these documents only provide guidance for practitioners who model and then verify predicted coverage. Marty Barringer, Bernie Olson, and Tom Rubinstein agreed with the stated intend of the documents and offered guidance regarding coverage prediction verses coverage verification. Marty also noted that the L3Harris submission does not cover the case Chris identified. George Crouch noted that they do drive tests after installation to verify coverage verses the coverage predictions.

### **c. Work Summary:**

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 5 for a summary of current and future work items for the subcommittee and provided a brief statement regarding each one.

The Chair indicated that a project was approved for Revision F of TSB-88.2 and that an email quorum vote to approve the draft proposal for ballot will occur once drafting in Working Group 2 is complete.

The Chair indicated that Working Group 1 plans to review the L3Harris proposal and make a recommendation regarding possible revisions to the Recommended Methods for Technology-Independent Narrowband Performance Verification Revision E (TSB-88.3-E).

The Chair indicated that Working Group 1 plans to review the near-far interference issue at 700/800 MHz and make a recommendation regarding possible revisions to the Recommended Methods for Technology-Independent Narrowband Performance Modeling Revision E (TSB-88.1-E) and/or revisions to the Recommended Methods for Technology-Independent Narrowband Performance Verification Revision E (TSB-88.3-E).

The Chair indicated that the new TSB "NOTICE" page was applied to both TSB-88.1-E and TSB-88.3-E when they were published last year.

The Chair reminded the participants that TIA was requested to apply the new TSB "NOTICE" Page to the following published TSBs during the October 2018 quorum meeting:

- TSB-88.4 Wireless Communications Systems Performance in Noise and Interference-Limited Situations Part 4: Recommended Methods for Technology-Independent Broadband Performance Modeling [December 2016]
- TSB-88.5 Wireless Communications Systems Performance in Noise and Interference-Limited Situations Part 5: Recommended Methods for Technology-Independent Broadband Performance Verification [December 2016]
- TSB-176-A Radiowave Propagation – Path Loss – Measurement and Validation [March 2017]

Victoria Mitchell indicated TIA would take care of re-issuing the documents identified above.

The Chair then called the participants' attention to slide 6 for a summary of TIA documents published by this subcommittee and noted that the summary is provided for informational purposes.

### **7. New Business:**

The Chair asked if there was any new business to bring before the TR-8.18 subcommittee. None was offered.

### **8. Review of Assignments:**

The Chair is to submit an Existing Project Request form to the TIA Standards Department for revision of project number TIA-PN-88.2-E, Wireless Communication Systems Performance in Noise and Interference-Limited Situations Part 2: Propagation and Noise. [New]

The Chair is to hold a 15-day email quorum vote to approve the TSB-88.2 Revision F draft proposal for ballot once drafting in Working Group 2 is complete. [New]

#### 9. Schedule Next Meeting:

The Chair requested 30 minutes of meeting time on the schedule for the next meeting.

#### 10. Adjourn:

Dwight Smith moved, and Todd Summers seconded, a motion to adjourn the meeting at approximately 11:19 Eastern Time (Charlotte local time). The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. An attendance roster is on file with the TIA Standards Department.
