#### 1. Call to Order:

The Chair called the meeting to order at approximately 14:16 Central Time (Des Moines local time) and volunteered to act as secretary. The Chair indicated that all relevant documents are on the TR-8.5 FTP site.

#### 2. Record of Attendance:

The electronic sign-in code was provided and a summary of the electronic attendance is provided later in this report. A quorum was established with 13 of 13 eligible voting organizations present.

#### 3. Review and Approve Agenda:

The Chair noted that the meeting agenda had been distributed by TIA prior to the meeting and that it is available as 19-011. The Chair then called the participants' attention to the TIA Participation Notice and Important Notice for Participation (see above) and asked for a motion to accept the June meeting agenda. John Lambrou moved, and Josh Johnson seconded, a motion to accept the June meeting agenda as written. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### 4. Review and Approve Last Meeting Report:

The Chair noted that the previous meeting report had been distributed by TIA prior to the meeting and that it is available as 19-010. The Chair then asked for a motion to accept the February meeting report. Josh Johnson moved, and Jim Downes seconded, a motion to accept the February meeting report as written. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### 5. TIA IPR Policy:

The Chair called the participants' attention to Note 2 on the meeting agenda for information regarding the TIA IPR Policy (see above) that was read to the participants earlier in the day. The Chair asked the question "is there knowledge of patents, the use of which may be essential to any document being considered during this meeting that anyone would like to disclose at this time"? There was no new IPR identified.

#### 6. Old Business:

The Chair called the participants' attention to 19-014 for a summary of the subcommittee activities since the previous meeting. The Chair then called the participants' attention to slide 2, and noted that no conference calls were held since the February meeting.

#### a. Disposition of ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAJB-A Tier 1 Location Services Specification:

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 3 and indicated that the TIA assigned project number for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition is ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAJB-A and that Motorola Solutions is the document editor. The Chair also indicated that the document was published as TIA-102.BAJB-A in November 2014 and that the latest documents are in the "Tier 1 Location Service" subfolder.

The Chair provided the following summary of the February meeting: a) the document is due for ANSI 5-year review, b) the editor provided comments in comment matrix 19-002 that identify duplicated text that should be deleted to align with the rest of the document suite, five references that should be updated, and editorial cleanup of the Foreword, and c) a comment period closing April 30<sup>th</sup> was established.

The Chair indicated that the comment period closed April 30<sup>th</sup> with no additional comments and no requests for more time to review the document.

The Chair indicated that TIA recently released the 2019 Style Guide that now defines "dated" and "undated" reference methods. The "dated" method specifies a specific edition (revision) of the referenced document whereas the "undated" method identifies the edition (revision) of the referenced document at the time of publication, but the latest edition (revision) of the referenced document (including any addenda) is utilized.

The Chair indicated that comment M07 of comment matrix 19-002-R1 was revised to record proposed revisions to utilize the "undated" reference method, and was distributed June 14<sup>th</sup>. The Chair proceeded to slide 4 and indicated that the Revision B-v1 draft proposal 19-012 incorporates the proposed resolutions recorded in comment matrix 19-002-R2 and was also distributed June 14<sup>th</sup>. The Chair then indicated that the Revision B-v2 draft proposal 19-012-R1 accepts all change tracking and was distributed June 14<sup>th</sup> as well.

The Chair indicated that none of the comments is substantive and that the next step is to consider a document action which could be: a) revise, b) reaffirm, c) request an extension, d) demote to TIA only, or e) withdraw. The Chair provided a summary of each of the possible actions and indicated that the Chair recommends the participants consider approving a project for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition (Revision B) of the document with the proposed scope of addressing the comments identified by the editor.

Tom Hengeveld moved, and Josh Johnson seconded, a motion to open a project for Revision of ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAJB-A Tier 1 Location Services Specification with scope of addressing the comments recorded in comment matrix 19-002-R2. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. The Chair took an assignment to submit an Existing Project Request form to the TIA Standards Department for Revision B.

Tom Hengeveld moved, and Josh Johnson seconded, a motion to issue a Ballot for contribution 19-012-R1, Revision B-v2 draft proposal for the Tier 1 Location Services Specification 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition, with project number ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAJB-B. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. The Chair took an assignment to submit a Ballot Authorization form to the TIA Standards Department for the Revision B-v2 draft proposal.

#### b. Disposition of ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAEB-B IP Data Bearer Service Specification:

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 5 and indicated that the TIA assigned project number for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition is ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAEB-B and that Motorola Solutions is the document editor. The Chair also indicated that the document was published as TIA-102.BAEB-B in September 2014 and that the latest documents are in the "IP Data Bearer Service" subfolder.

The Chair provided the following summary of the February meeting: a) the document is due for ANSI 5-year review, b) the editor provided comments in comment matrix 19-004 that identify 10 references that should be updated and editorial cleanup of the Foreword and clauses 1.2 and 1.3, and c) a comment period closing May 31<sup>st</sup> was established.

The Chair indicated that the comment period closed May 31<sup>st</sup> with no additional comments and no requests for more time to review the document.

The Chair indicated that TIA recently released the 2019 Style Guide that now defines "dated" and "undated" reference methods (see agenda item 6a for more details).

The Chair indicated that comment M05 of comment matrix 19-002-R1 was revised to record proposed revisions to utilize the "undated" reference method, and was distributed June 14<sup>th</sup>. The Chair also indicated that the Revision C-v1 draft proposal 19-013 incorporates the proposed resolutions recorded in comment matrix 19-002-R2 and was distributed June 14<sup>th</sup> as well.

The Chair proceeded to slide 6 and indicated that none of the comments is substantive and that the next step is to consider a document action which could be: a) revise, b) reaffirm, c) request an extension, d) demote to TIA only, or e) withdraw. The Chair provided a summary of each of the possible actions and indicated that the Chair recommends the participants consider approving a project for the 4<sup>th</sup> Edition (Revision C) of the document with the proposed scope of addressing the comments identified by the editor.

Tom Hengeveld moved, and John Lambrou seconded, a motion to open a project for Revision of ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAEB-B IP Data Bearer Service Specification with scope of addressing the comments recorded in comment matrix 19-004-R2. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. The Chair took an assignment to submit an Existing Project Request form to the TIA Standards Department for Revision C.

Tom Hengeveld moved, and John Lambrou seconded, a motion to issue a Ballot for contribution 19-013, Revision C-v1 draft proposal for the IP Data Bearer Service Specification 4<sup>th</sup> Edition, with project number ANSI/TIA-PN-102.BAEB-C. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. The Chair took an assignment to submit a Ballot Authorization form to the TIA Standards Department for the Revision C-v1 draft proposal.

#### c. Work Summary:

The Chair called the participants' attention to slide 7 for a summary of current and future work items for the subcommittee and provided a brief statement regarding each one.
